### **Winnipeg Jets Season Tickets**

Hart Jacob, Manager of Partnerships, and Norva Riddell, Senior Vice President of Sales & Chief Revenue Officer at True North Sports & Entertainment, presented to the Board regarding the initiatives being implemented by the Winnipeg Jets to actively involve the business community. In the past four years, TNSE has observed a decrease in season ticket purchases and is now exploring potential partnerships with medium-sized businesses to assess the potential benefits of ticket packages to benefit their businesses.

### National Mentor Development Program for Women in the Skilled Trades

The Canadian Apprenticeship Forum (CAF-FCA) has launched the National Mentor Development Program for Women in the Skilled Trades. This 4-month virtual program, offered free of charge, aims to develop mentorship skills for women and gender diverse individuals in the trades. The program addresses retention barriers for women in trades and is supported by research and training best practices. ### MCAM Post-Secondary Scholarship - Marc Lynch Award

The Marc Lynch Award is a legacy in honour of Marc Lynch of Randall Plumbing and Heating Ltd. The scholarship is intended for MCAM member companies' staff and families. It will be awarded to students pursuing a post-secondary program in any recognized educational institution and discipline.

# **Psvchological Injuries - WCB**

The Board discussed WCB's extension of coverage for psychological injuries. Starting May 1, 2023, revisions to the Workers Compensation Board of Manitoba's policy on Adjudication of Psychological Injury Claims came into force. WCB now recognizes that enduring an excessive workload over time can be considered a traumatic event, leading to a compensable claim. Concern was raised given the unique work environment, remote jobsite locations and long work hours of the construction industry. The Board requested clarification of the change. Related claims would impact loss time performance, limiting contractors' ability to qualify for jobs as well as WCB rates. The Board will continue conversations surrounding the topic and requested the Executive Director engage the WCB.

# Bill 7

A discussion unfolded concerning Bill 7. Aimed at repealing the Act passed by the previous government that limited the utilization of Project Labour Agreements (PLAs) in public construction ventures. The Executive Director will have further discussions with industry partners with the intention of better understanding their positions as well as where the responsibilities of PLAs reside within the legal framework of the province.
