It was clarified that the number of hours worked, within workplace and industry standards, wouldn't alone warrant a psychological injury claim. Workers have the ability to refuse overtime and managers should foster a culture where employees feel comfortable discussing their workload and hours.

## Apprenticeship Manitoba FAQ – 1:1 Apprentice-to-Journeyperson Ratio

The current standard is to maintain a ratio of no more than two apprentices per journeyperson (a 2:1 ratio). However, the department is now adjusting this to a 1:1 apprentice-to-journeyperson ratio.
