

A MESSAGE FROM MCAM PRESIDENT- Wayne McKenzie

September Board of Directors Meeting Highlights

The MCAM Board of Directors is comprised of a cross section of Industry members; Residential through Heavy Industrial, urban and rural, sub-contractors, engineers and associate members. The Board meets monthly September through June and is served by standing committees, advisory councils and working groups.

BACnet Designs

Grant Wichenko, President of Appin Associates, updated the board on evolving BACnet design practices. Traditionally, in construction contracts, the data from equipment (CRACs, UPSs) came from a third party BACnet or proprietary gateway that were supplied and installed by a third-party integrator or the Controls Subcontractor. However, the industry is changing, and equipment suppliers provide and install BACnet gateways at the factory. The BACnet information is now a component that is managed from design submittal to installation as well as the commissioning and turnover processes outlined in the Construction Agreement. Appin's Networked Controls Model supports MEP trades by aligning with current Trade Definitions and responsibilities. The MCAM board recognizes the need to anticipate industry changes and may suggest reviewing trade definitions and engaging in proactive discussions to adapt accordingly.

CCA-1 Review

The National Trade Contractors Council of Canada (NTCCC) are conducting a review the Canadian Construction Documents Committee (CCA-1) contract for the purpose of providing cautionary notes and observations. Feedback from MCAM has been requested, and a subcommittee will be established to assist with this review.

Social Procurement Roundtable

MCAM representatives participated in the Social Procurement Roundtable with the City of Winnipeg. The Board expressed interest in exploring this topic further and will follow up with MCAC to compare procurement procedures across Canada.

Apprenticeship Ratio Update

MCAM representative on the Apprenticeship and Certification Board reported October 30th is the deadline for the ratio change to be implemented. Once in effect, all new apprentices will be trained at a 1:1 ratio, current apprentices will maintain their 2:1 ratio as long as they remain at their current employer. Meeting with Minister of Finance

Executive Director Ramona Coey and MCAM Board representatives, Past President, Julien Lafleche and National Director, Brad Mason toured ServcoCanada with Honourable Adrien Sala, Minister of Finance. Discussions focused on Manitoba's developing Energy Policy designed to meet Manitoba's growing energy needs as well as strengthen Manitoba's capacity to support and attract private investment.

Prompt Payment Update

Executive Director, Ramona Coey and Brad Mason (ServcoCanada) will serve on the Manitoba Builders' Liens Modernization Advisory Council reviewing draft regulations for Builders Lien Act. To bring The Builders' Liens Amendment Act (Prompt Payment) into force the minister must first designate a person or entity as the authority to adjudicate disputes (the adjudication authority) in November/December 2024 (regulation #1). This will enable a second regulation to be developed to fully implement the prompt payment scheme, including forms, by April 1, 2025.

Energy Policy Consultation

Executive Director Ramona Coey attended an Energy Policy Consultation that laid the groundwork for the upcoming energy policy. Efforts are underway to develop plans for future initiatives.
